The Mazda Cosmo is a grand touring coupé that was produced by Mazda from 1967 to 1995. Throughout its history, the Cosmo served as a "halo" vehicle for Mazda, with the first Cosmo successfully launching the Mazda Wankel engine. The final generation of Cosmo served as Mazda's flagship vehicle in Japan, being sold as the Eunos Cosmo through its luxury Eunos division in Japan. The Mazda RX-7 is a front-engine, rear-wheel-drive rotary engine powered sports car manufactured and marketed by Mazda from 1978–2002 across three generations—all noted for using a compact, lightweight Wankel rotary engine..
